NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICING

Neighbourhood policing provides the foundation upon which we deliver many of our services to local communities. Since we introduced dedicated neighbourhood policing teams in 2006 we have sought to embed them to ensure that our staff and services are responsive and accessible to the needs of local people.



- We will be visible, accessible and responsive to people in our neighbourhoods using surveys to track levels of public satisfaction. This will enable us to make changes to the way we do business, ensuring that the needs of communities are at the heart of our decision-making and service delivery.
- Our neighbourhood teams will be fully integrated with all other parts of the organisation to ensure that there is a wealth of information and knowledge about the people living in our communities.
- Neighbourhood teams will work alongside our partner agencies to deliver sustainable solutions to local issues.

Our neighbourhood policing teams are based at the following police stations:

Rhyl, Prestatyn, St Asaph, Denbigh, Ruthin, Corwen and Llangollen.

Since the Local Criminal Justice Board was formed in 2003 North Wales has seen an 18% reduction in crime.

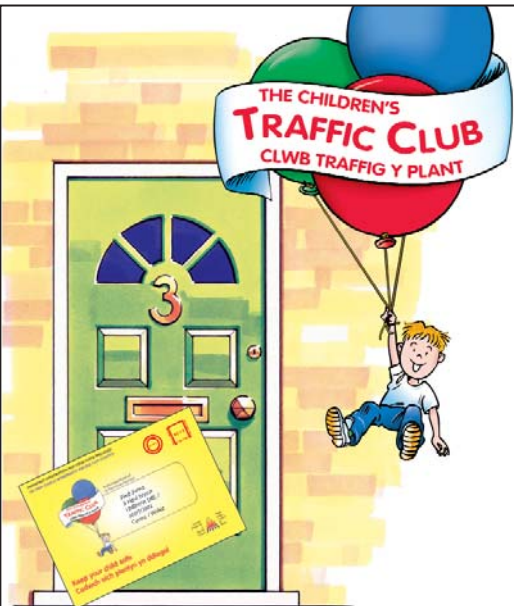

BE SAFE, BE SECURE

YOUR HOME Home Security is the best way to reduce your chances of being burgled. A lot of burglaries are spur of the moment, as a burglar may see an open window or other easy point of entry and take their chance.

When you go out, always close and lock the external doors and windows - even if you are just going out for a short time.

OLDER PEOPLE Older people may feel more vulnerable to some crimes, but are actually less likely to become victims. A few simple steps can also help reduce your risk of crime.

Have a list of useful numbers by your telephone. These may include the number of your family, local police station, local council etc.

Don't keep large sums of cash at home - use a Bank / Building Society account instead.

BOGUS CALLERS Most people who call at your home will be genuine, but sometimes someone may turn up unannounced, with the intention of tricking their way into your home. If someone calls on you;

- **STOP** Are you expecting anybody? Do they have an appointment?
- **CHAIN** Secure the door bar or chain before opening the door.
- **CHECK** Ask for and double-check the caller's I.D.

DENBIGHSHIRE CRIME AND DISORDER PARTNERSHIP SHARE THE HOME OFFICE DEFINITION OF ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (ASB) AS BEING BEHAVIOUR WHICH CAUSES OR IS LIKELY TO CAUSE, HARASSMENT, ALARM OR DISTRESS TO ONE OR MORE PERSONS NOT IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD.

This can include acts directed at people such as, verbal abuse, intimidation and bullying, environmental damage such as criminal damage and graffiti. Noise nuisance, drug taking, begging and drunken behaviour. This is not an exhaustive list.

The partnership takes reports of ASB seriously. North Wales Police, Social Landlords and Denbighshire County Council Community Safety Team will investigate fully any incidents reported to them. We understand the impact ASB can have on individuals and communities and the partnership works with a range of agencies and services to tackle it. For more information on how we are tackling ASB across Denbighshire please see the ASB strategy on Denbighshire County Council website.

BETH YW CAM-DRIN DOMESTIG?

WHAT IS DOMESTIC ABUSE?

Domestic abuse is the use of physical, sexual or psychological abuse to gain power and control over another person with whom the abuser is having an intimate relationship. It can happen at any time during a relationship, including after a couple has separated and pregnancy and birth are often the trigger for abuse to start. It can also be violence between family members.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

If you are suffering from abuse there are four important steps to take:

- Recognise that it is happening to you.
- Accept that you are not to blame.
- Talk to someone.
- Get help and support.

Domestic abuse is a crime and should not be tolerated, tackling domestic abuse is everybody's responsibility..... Don't tolerate it, report it.

DRUGS

Drug related harms:

- Combining drugs and alcohol will significantly increase health risks which can vary greatly from person to person.
- Lots of different things can be added to illegal drugs, because no one is responsible for ensuring standards of hygiene and safety.

Drugs and the law:

- Passing around or giving your friends drugs is 'supplying' and carries a harsher sentence than possession.
- Some countries will not let you visit them if you have a conviction for drugs.

ALCOHOL

Alcohol related harms:

- Alcohol and crime: 1.2 million violent crimes are alcohol related.
- Alcohol and mortality: 22,000 premature deaths per annum
- Alcohol and the economy: 17 million working days lost through alcohol related absence.
- Alcohol and suicide: up to 1000 suicides

Binge drinking can make you vulnerable to many alcohol related harm.

Top Tips for Reducing Alcohol Related Harm

- Always have a hearty meal before drinking
- Avoid drinking in rounds as this can encourage you to drink at a faster pace
- Have a few alcohol free days per week
- Have a soft drink between alcoholic drinks
- Listen to people if they tell you that you are drinking too much. Help is available



ALCOHOL AND THE LAW:

- It is illegal to sell alcohol to anyone under 18.
- It is illegal to buy alcohol on behalf of anyone who is under the age of 18.
