Fodd bynnag, os medrwyd fodloni 3 maen prawf syml gallwch wneud cais am ganiatâd i Gyngor Sir Ddinbych a pharhau i ddefnyddio'r Parciau Ailgylchu :-

- Rhaid i'r cerbyd fod wedi'i gofrestru i CHI, nid busnes neu gorff arall
- Rhaid i'r cerbyd fod wedi'i gofrestru i gyfeiriad yn Sir Ddinbych
- Ni ddylai'r cerbyd fod ag unrhyw arwyddion neu hysbyseb.

Os nad ydych yn bodloni'r amodau hyn, ni fydd caniatâd i chi ddod â'ch cerbyd i Barciau Ailgylchu Sir Ddinbych. Ar y tudalennau canlynol, mae cyngor ar sut i drin eich sbwriel yn y dyfodol.

## Pam fod angen y cyfyngiad hwn?

Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi cyflwyno'r cyfyngiad hwn am bedwar prif reswm:-

- Roedd defnyddwyr busnes yn camddefnyddio'r hen system ac roedd treth dalwyr y Cyngor yn talu'r costau
- Bu rhaid newid y system i ateb anghenion deddfwriaeth amgylcheddol.
- I leihau tagfeydd ar adegau prysur a lleihau amser aros i ddefnyddwyr y Parciau Ailgylchu
- Mae faniau sy'n symud yn risg i ddiogelwch y cyhoedd a staff yn y Parciau Ailgylchu.

## Do you drive a van, a pick-up or use a trailer?

Denbighshire County Council restricts the types of vehicles allowed to use Recycling Parks. If you drive a vehicle other than a standard car, or if you use a trailer, please read on.

Drivers of certain vehicles must be in possession of a permit to use Denbighshire Recycling Parks to dispose of rubbish. The types of vehicles affected include: -

- Lorries
- Vans
- Pick-ups
- Trailers (with more than one axle)
- Mini-buses
- Any vehicle that might be seen as "commercial"

**COMPANY VEHICLES, HIRED VEHICLES AND BORROWED VEHICLES WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ACCESS THE SITES.**

However, if you can satisfy three simple criteria you can apply for a permit from Denbighshire County Council and continue to use the Recycling Parks: -

- the vehicle must be registered to YOU, not a business or other organisation
- the vehicle must be registered to an address in Denbighshire
- the vehicle must not be sign-written or display any advertising

If you cannot satisfy these three conditions, you will not be permitted to bring your vehicle into Denbighshire's Recycling Parks. On the following pages you will find advice on how you should deal with your rubbish in future.

## Why is this necessary?

Denbighshire County Council introduced this restriction for four main reasons:-

- Business users were abusing the old system and Council tax payers were footing the bill.
- Changes had to be made to meet the needs of environmental legislation.
- To reduce congestion at peak times and reduce waiting times for most Recycling Park users.
- The movement of vans poses a risk to the safety of the public and staff at Recycling Parks.

## Building rubble, bricks, tiles, soil

The above wastes are not classed as domestic waste (even if they originate from a household) and Denbighshire has no obligation to accept this type of waste at its sites. We do accept small amounts of this waste, but no more than 3 bags per visit. If more of this type of waste needs to be disposed of then a skip from a licensed company should be hired.

## If I don't qualify for a permit, what should I do?

Denbighshire County Council offers waste collection services for bulky household or trade waste and a range of trade waste collection services; telephone 01824 706101 for more details. Alternatively, a number of local and national companies offer waste management services:-

This list is not exhaustive, try the Yellow Pages for more options. Remember that local charities, scrap metal merchants or architectural salvage firms can also offer alternatives to just disposing of rubbish.

## Your Recycling Park permit

Remember, if you use a car to bring your rubbish to the Recycling Park you do not need a permit.

If you are issued a permit, you will receive a disc which must be displayed on the windscreen of your vehicle and a book of 'Van Ban' vouchers. Every time you visit the recycling park you must submit a 'Van Ban' voucher to the attendant.

**IF A PERMIT IS NOT DISPLAYED AND A VOUCHER SUBMITTED TO AN ATTENDANT YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ONTO THE SITE.**
