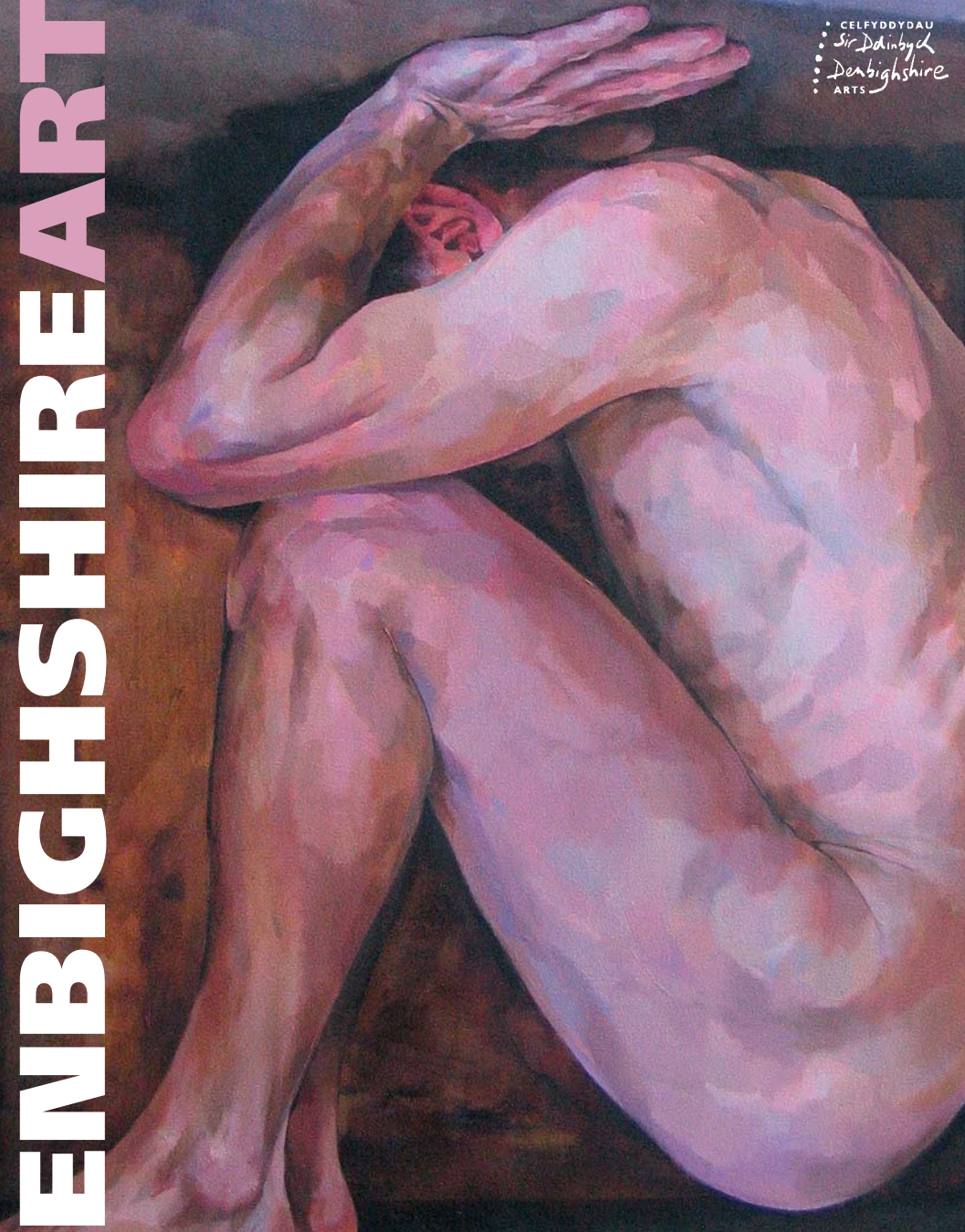

Imperfect Transcriptions is a new series of colour photographs by David Gepp – extraordinarily vivid studies of grasses, gorse and meadow flowers which abound with rhythm and intense colour. The photographs are shown alongside the poetry of R S Thomas and Chopin's piano pieces, the 24 Études. The exhibition invites us into an intimate relationship with the music and the natural environment, and considers the deep issues of life – chaos and order, the everyday and the sublime, life and death, pain and beauty.

Three artists from North Wales are looking at the landscape, each with their own perspective. Martin Collins work looks outwards to the horizon and the wider view of coastlines and rugged mountains; his connection with the North Wales Landscape begins on foot, with good days yielding a painting 'en plein air'. John Hedley aims to highlight the beauty and variety of some of the more enclosed natural worlds that we take for granted and indeed often hardly ever notice. Terry Mart is working with images that display simple narrative threads through juxtapositions of buildings, nature and people, with the landscape becoming more metaphorical than topographical.

Le Chéile

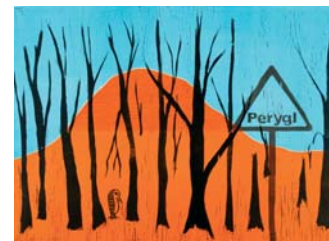
A Welsh-Irish collaborative project – communication through printmaking

Co-ordinated by Alison Craig and Monica de Bath, it includes work by more than 15 printmakers, and is an ongoing project.

This series of work originated from an earlier project about illusionism and deception called *Smoke and Mirrors*; the work is a product of a search for a definitive image on the theme of escapology. Developed in a period shadowed by extraordinary rendition and covert human migration across the continents, the compositions show an individual tightly confined within a crate like cell. Issues such as social and psychological isolation, political oppression and the high risk strategies employed in acts of voluntary/coerced human trafficking are being explored.

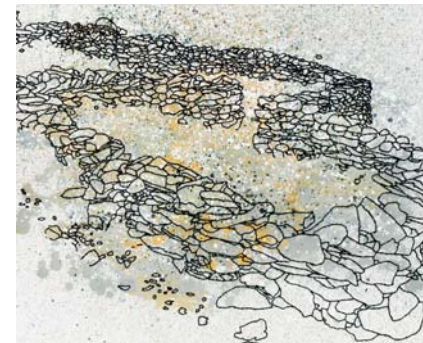
Wise and Foolish Dreamers
