Introduction

To make recycling easier, Denbighshire County Council has introduced a new recycling system into your area.

We have increased our kerbside recycling scheme to include cardboard, tetrapaks and hard plastics (yogurt pots, ready meal trays etc) as well as tins, cans, glass bottles, plastic bottles and paper.

The blue and white sacks will be collected once every two weeks. Please refer to the calendar accompanying this information leaflet for your collection day.

This booklet contains information about the items that can be recycled in your blue and white sacks, what happens to the recycling once it has been collected and some answers to frequently asked questions.

Your Blue & White Sacks

Your sacks should only be used for the types of waste listed on the previous page. Please do not put any of the following into your sacks.

No thank you



- Garden waste
- Food / Liquids
- Plastic Wrap (e.g. cellophane, crisp packets, carrier bags)
- Nappies
- Hoover Dust
- Textiles (i.e. clothes, shoes)

1. Please wash out all tins and cans, glass bottles and jars, plastic bottles, plastic trays etc.



2. To make the most of your recycling sacks, crush, squash or flatten materials where possible.

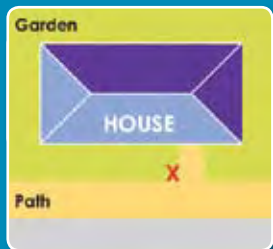


3. Please remember to only put in the materials specified on page 3 of this leaflet. Putting the wrong materials in can contaminate the whole load which could result in it having to be sent to landfill.



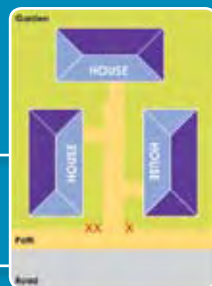
Putting Your Blue & White Sacks Out for Collection

Please have your sacks ready for 07.00 on your day of collection (you can put it out the night before if you wish).



The sacks needs to be placed kerbside (i.e./ where your drive meets the public highway).

Residents that have shared driveways need to place their sacks as follows:



What Happens to My Recycling?



The recycling sacks are collected and loaded onto the recycling collection vehicle



When the recycling collection vehicle returns to the council depot its load is tipped in to the recycling bays.



When we have sufficient quantities of material it is loaded and then taken to the processing facility (MRF- Material Recycling Facility).



Using the latest technology and equipment the processing facility separates the mixed recyclables.



The separated materials are then bailed



The bailed materials are then turned in to new products.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can I recycle different types of plastic?

A. Yes you can - as long as the different containers are rinsed clean then all different types of plastic can be recycled.

Q. Can I recycle carrier bags / plastic wrap?

A. We cannot collect carrier bags / plastic wrap, only plastic containers. Many supermarkets have take back schemes for carrier bags or provide incentives for reusing them.

Q. Why aren't we separating the recyclable materials and collecting them separately?

A. Collecting the recyclable materials mixed together means less containers for you to store and also enables us to collect a broader range of recyclable materials. With the way technology has advanced separating the materials is easy.

Q. Why is the paper and cardboard collected in a separate bag to the rest of the recyclable material?

A. At the time of writing, the market value of paper and cardboard is low, but should the market improve having the paper and cardboard separated would enable us to obtain a better price for the material and therefore reduce the cost of providing the service.

Q. Is the material we collect sent abroad?

A. Once separated all the material is sent to UK processors and merchants

Q. What happened to the blue box system?

A. The contract for the operation of the blue box system has finished. Denbighshire County Council now deals with the recycling service in house.

Q. If I have a blue box, can I keep it?

A. If you were previously on the blue box scheme, and would like to keep your blue box then we are happy for you to do so. If you would like Denbighshire County Council to remove the blue box then please contact our customer service team on 01824 706100 / 101.

C. Gaf i ailgylchu gwahanol fathau o blastig?

A. Cewch – cyn bellied â bod y gwahanol gynwysyddion yn cael eu rinsio'n lân gellill ailgylchu pob math gwahanol o blastig.

C. Gaf i ailgylchu bagiau cario / lapion plastig?

A. Allwn ni ddim casglu bagiau cario / lapion plastig, dim ond cynwysyddion plastig. Mae gan lawer o archfarchnadoedd gynlluniau dychwelyd ar gyfer bagiau cario neu maent yn cymhell pobl i'w hailddefnyddio.

C. Pam nad ydym yn gwahanu'r deunyddiau ailgylchu a'u casglu ar wahân?

A. Mae casglu'r deunyddiau ailgylchu'n gymysg yn golygu llai o gynwysyddion i chi orfod eu storio ac mae hefyd yn ein galluogi ni i gasglu ystod ehangach o ddeunyddiau ailgylchu. Gan fod technoleg wedi datblygu cymaint mae gwahanu'r deunyddiau'n hawdd.

C. Pam y cesgir papur a chardfrwdd mewn bag gwahanol i weddill y deunyddiau sy'n cael eu hailgylchu?

A. Adeg ysgrifennu, mae gwerth marchnad papur a chardfrwdd yn isel ond os byd y farchnad yn gwella Byddai cael y papur a'r cardfrwdd ar wahân o gymorth i gael gwell pris ac yn lleihau cost darparu gwasaeneth.

Q. Ydy'r deunyddiau fyddwn ni'n eu casglu'n cael eu hanfon dramor?

A. Unwaith y bydd y deunyddiau i gyd wedi eu gwahanu fe'u hanfonir at broseswyr a masnachwyr y DU.

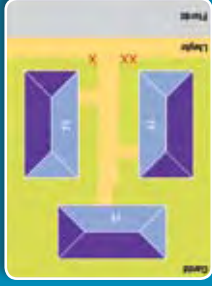
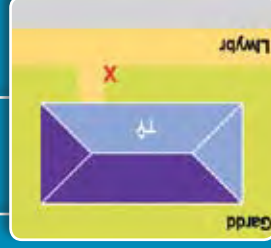


Rhoi'r Sachau Glas a Gwyn i'w Gasglu.

Mae angen gosod y sachau ar ochr y palmant (h.y. lle bydd eich dreif yn cyfarfod â'r briffordd).

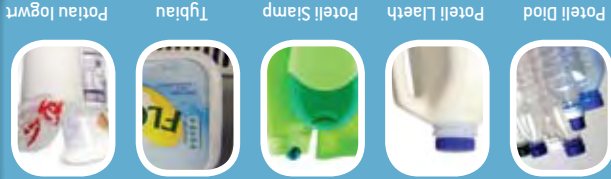
