DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC SPACE PROTECTION ORDER 2020

Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014
(Chapter 2)

RHYL TOWN

Notice is hereby given that Denbighshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 59, 63 and 72 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (“the Act”) and under all other enabling powers, proposes to make the following order:

The draft of the proposed order is set out below. Further details and reasons for making the order may be inspected during normal office hours at Caledfryn, Smithfield Road, Denbigh, by prior arrangements. The proposed order is also published on the Council’s website www.denbighshire.gov.uk.

Anti-Social Behaviour

1. An authorised person may request that an individual, or a group, within the restricted area disperse, where they reasonably suspect any person in that group is causing, or likely to cause nuisance, alarm, harassment or distress to any other person.
2. A person engaged in ASB is prohibited from remaining (either individually or in a group of two or more people) within the restricted area after an authorised person has requested that the group disperse and must not return for a specified period of up to 48 hours.
3. A person is prohibited from loitering in shop doorways within the restricted area, with the apparent purpose of causing nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress.
4. A person is prohibited from loitering in a state of alcohol or drug induced intoxication within the restricted area.

Begging

1. A person is prohibited from approaching any person for the purposes of obtaining money by begging or from positioning themselves in order to beg.
2. A person is prohibited from remaining seated on the ground where it may give the impression that they are engaging in or intending to engage in begging.

Street Drinking

1. A person is prohibited to be in possession of an open container of alcohol in a public place (even if empty) within the area designated by the public space protection order.
2. It is prohibited to be in possession of an unopened container of alcohol in a public place within the restricted area in such circumstances that would lead a reasonable person to suspect that such a container is likely to be opened and consumed in a public place within the restricted area.
3. A person is required to surrender any alcohol in their possession when asked to do so by an authorised person in the restricted area.
