Any street trading consent does not invalidate the need for the applicant(s) to seek any further licences which may be required, e.g. Street Collection Permit for the sale of articles where the proceeds are donated to a charitable cause; consent of the highways authority for sitting obstructions on the street; food registration regulations for the selling of food to the public.

Conditions attached to street trading consent:

The trader(s) named in the consent must not:-

1. trade outside the hours and days permitted in the consent,

2. employ or use in connection with trading subject of this consent, anyone under the age of 17 years,

3. cause annoyance or danger to any resident or person,

4. cause any obstruction to the street or persons using it,

5. use any means of amplifying sounds signifying sales,

6. use any stall, table or cart or the like unless specifically permitted to do so,

7. sell articles other than those specified in the consent.
