#### **Denbighshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Variation No.2 Carrog Order 202 .**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Denbighshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposes to make the above-named Order, the effect of which will be as described in the schedule below.
