Deemed Dedication of Rights of Way.

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

WE [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] OF [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] PENYCAE, WREXHAM, LL14 1UA DO SOLEMNLY AND
SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

1. We are and have been since 28th November 1979 the owners of the land known as Llandyn Mountain (formally part of the farm and lands known as Llandyn Hall), Llangollen, Denbighshire more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 30th day of September 2010 we deposited with Denbighshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that the way coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as a footpath.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 30th day of September 2010 referred to in 2 above and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over our property.
